His permanent duty station after training was Malmstrom AFB, serving most of his time with the 10th Missile Squadron, with a short temporary duty assignment to the weapons storage area on Malmstrom. Mike was deployed to Saudi Arabia, and assigned with the 4409th Security Police Squadron. He got out in 1998 with an honorable discharge as an E-4 (Senior Airman).
