

SUN RIVER ELECTRIC SCHOLARSHIPS

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS:

Sun River Electric Cooperative is offering \$1,000 scholarships to students who live on the Sun River Electric system. This scholarship will be awarded based upon a written application.

The qualifications for this scholarship are as follows:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior in high school.
- Applicant must have a GPA of at least 2.5.
- Applicant's parent or guardian must be a member of Sun River Electric Cooperative.
- Applicant must be planning to attend a University, College, Community College, or a College of Technology in the state of Montana or out of state.
- Applicant must include a personal statement describing the goals they wish to attain by furthering their education.

CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS:

Sun River Electric Cooperative is offering \$1,000 scholarships to students that are currently enrolled in college or a trade school. This scholarship will be awarded based on the written application.

The qualifications for this scholarship are as follows:

- Applicant must have a college GPA of at least 2.5, please include the most recent college transcripts.
- Applicant or Applicant's parents or guardian must be a member of Sun River Electric Cooperative.
- Applicant must be attending a University, College, Community College or a College of Technology in the state of Montana or out of state.
- Applicant must write a personal statement about future goals, employment, and need.
- Applicant must have received a SREC scholarship upon graduating from high school.
- Limit an applicant may only receive continuing education funds for three years.

LUCAS FOWLER MEMORIAL - LINE WORKER SCHOLARSHIPS

Sun River Electric Cooperative is offering a \$5,000 scholarship to individuals planning to pursue a career in the utility industry. These scholarships will be awarded based upon written application and the following information.

- Applicant must be a graduating senior, high school graduate or equivalent.
- Applicant must live in the Sun River Electric Cooperative service area but does not have to be a SREC member.
- Applicant must include a letter of recommendation.
- Applicant must have a GPA of at least 2.5.
- Applicant must include a personal statement. This statement should include information about their future goals, employment and need.
- A payment of \$2,000 will be paid at registration time and the balance of \$3,000 upon proof of graduation.

Applications are due February 28, 2025.
