CREATING amazing metal signs, wall decorations, and adding a special touch to antique metal items comes naturally to Nikki Gulick. She has always had a love of art. She grew up on her family farm west of Fairfield. Her parents have been members of Sun River Electric Cooperative since 1981.

When Nikki decided she wanted to farm with her parents and be a stayat-home mom for her two sons, she decided to start her own business — Iron Horse Metal Art. It all began with her dad's plasma cutter and her natural artist talent. Everything she makes is an original creation.

She also takes old metal pieces such as milk cans, buckets, shovels and wheelbarrows that were just sitting in a shed and makes them into pieces of art that are now sitting in someone's home or on their deck. When a customer contacts her with an idea, she draws up a freehand design proof and once they approve it, the cutting begins.
