• MECA offers one \$500 scholarships in SREC's district. Deadline: January 31, 2018.

- Basin Electric Power Cooperative will offer one \$1,000 scholarship systemwide. Deadline: January 31, 2018. 216771
- Sun River Electric offers 18 \$1,000 scholarships, two to each school in the SREC service territory. Deadline: April 3, 2018.

Sun River Electric will offer two new scholarships this year:

- A continuing education scholarship for \$1,000 to students already in college. Deadline is April 3, 2018.
- And an electric line worker scholarship for \$1,000 to those individuals interested in electric line work. Deadline is April 3, 2018.
