

SREC wins 2018 NWPPA Safety Award





Safety contest awards are based on a review of each utility's safety contest form, the number of recordable injury/illness cases (the incident rate) in 2017, and the lost work days (the severity rate) in 2017. Sun River Electric Cooperative is in the 40,001-80,000 hours of exposure category. SREC is proud of 16 years of no-lost-time accidents.

Check manufacturers' instructions to make sure your solar lights are situated to receive sufficient sunlight to recharge during the day.
