golf. He is glad to have made it back home and is looking forward to serving the cooperative and its



Operation Round-Up Update

S un River Electric Cooperative has donated \$1,000 each to Augusta and Fort Shaw communities for flood relief.

Operation Round-Up is a charitable fund program designed to financially help community groups in need within the Sun River Electric Cooperative (SREC) service area. The fund is made of change from SREC members who have rounded up their monthly billing to the nearest dollar. For example: If you sign up for Operation Round-up and your monthly bill is \$64.35, it would be rounded up to \$65. The extra 65 cents goes into the fund.

At this time there are 230 members participating in the program. SREC's Operation Roundup has donated to the Teton County Ambulance for new CPR training equipment, Conrad's City Hall for handicap-accessible entrance doors, Pondera Medical Center for the purchase of a newer handicap-accessible van and to the Greenfield School for an automated external defibrillator (AED). 214240
